**Pit Bike Racing – Nominate on the day**

### 16” Pit Bike Challenge

Entry fee - \$2 per rider per Round (two motos)

Classes – 7&Under, 8-13, 14+

**Mystery Trophy 1-3 at end of Series**

### 16” Pit Bike Club Team Relay Racing

Entry fee is \$8 per team, per round (one moto)

Each team it consist of 4 riders, one rider must be female and one from each of the following age groups:- **10-12, 13-15, 16-18, 19+**. Four 16” pit bikes will be provided by SABMXA and all will be identical. Each moto will commence at the start gate and finish at the finish line with each rider riding approx ¼ of the track. At each relay point riders must change over within the boxed area. Points will be allocated for each moto in the series as follows 1<sup>st</sup> – 4pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 3 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 2pts and 4<sup>th</sup> – 1pt. Team with the most points at end of series will be declared the winner, equal points will be subject to count back.

**Awards 1-4 and Pit Bike Cup at end of Series**

# Conditions of Entry

- Must hold a current Sprocket or Open BMXA licence.
- All riders must be a financial member of a South Australian affiliated BMX Club.
- Club permit licences are not acceptable for this Event.
- If insufficient entries are received to form a Class, classes will be merged but scored as per Series Scoring schedule.
- Age determination is 2008 minus year of birth.
- Sprocket & Invitation classes, age on day.
- Riders will enter their natural age class where provided.
- Current allocated plate number and suffix must be used.
- Regulation plate and number colours apply to all participants and competitors. (ARA)
- No refunds, unless it is found after the close of entries that a rider is injured or becomes ill prior to the event and produces a medical certificate, in which case there will be a full refund.
- Riders who fail to register will not be included in moto draw.
- Random bike scrutineering will take place.  
*Disclaimer :Passing of a bicycle by a scrutineer does not warrant that it is deemed safe to ride.*
